Exploring National Board Certification

Teachers declare National Board Certification to be the best professional development they ever experience. The revised process allows teachers up to three years to complete the components rather than do them all in one school year. The cost is now about \$2,000, not paid all at once, but as you do each component. Many districts offer stipends for those who achieve. Research unequivocally shows students of national board certified teachers learn more. Join this session and learn about changes in the process, eligibility, cost, and time considerations. Apply National Board for Professional Teaching Standards to your work, and experience thinking like a candidate.
